Who Can Audition?

- 9th-12th grade Floyd Central Students
- 2nd - 8th graders who are either residents of Floyd County OR attend a NAFCS school

Roles

All roles are available. Please see attached list for character breakdown.

Priority will be given to High School students for named characters, aside from Gary the Snail, who will be played by a child. We will also be casting an ensemble of kids of varying ages to makeup the citizens of Bikini Bottom and the Pirate Chorus.

What Do I Prepare?

High Schoolers

- 16-32 bars of a musical theatre song. Please bring accompaniment sheet music. (a pianist will be provided)
- Bring jazz, character, or gym shoes. Dancers and non-dancers welcome.

Aspire Students

- Be prepared to sing the "Spongebob Squarepants" theme song.
- You may prepare the given dance, or create your own to the same music. We just want to see how you move!

2nd-8th Graders

- Be prepared to sing the "Spongebob Squarepants" theme song. Sheet music will be provided.
- Bring jazz shoes or gym shoes. Dancers and non-dancers welcome.

The choreography for the dance call will be provided in advance. Students may learn either video depending on their comfort or ability. The SpongeBob Musical Cast of Characters

SpongeBob SquarePants: The unlikely hero of our story. He works at the Krusty Krab as a fry cook, but hopes to one day be promoted to manager.

Patrick Star: SpongeBob's best friend. Patrick loves television and lives under a rock.

Sandy Cheeks: A science-minded land squirrel who lives under the sea.

Squidward Q. Tentacles: The cashier at the Krusty Krab, and neighbors with SpongeBob and Patrick. He may seem grumpy, but he secretly hopes to be a star.

Sheldon J. Plankton: The co-owner of the Chum Bucket, a rival restaurant to the Krusty Krab. A single-celled organism who wants to rule the world.

Karen Plankton: Co-owner of the Chum Bucket, with her husband Sheldon. She is a waterproof computer.

Eugene H. Krabs: Owner and founder of the Krusty Krab. He loves money more than anything, even his daughter Pearl.

Pearl Krabs: A teenage whale who just wants to rock n roll, and for her dad to understand her.

Mrs. Puff: A pufferfish who is the driving instructor at boat school. She likes to drink, so she doesn't do much driving.

Gary the Snail: SpongeBob's loyal pet who says "meow."

Patchy the Pirate: President of the SpongeBob SquarePants fan club, who keeps sneaking into the theatre to watch the show.

The Mayor: She is the #girlboss of the sea world.

Perch Perkins: An overdramatic news anchor.

Old Man Jenkins: He may be slow, but he sure is fast to stir up prejudice against land mammals.

Larry the Lobster: He loves to work out, and is recruited to maintain crowd control when things start to spiral.

The Electric Skates: A group of three teenage heartthrobs who ride skateboards and sing rock songs.

French Narrator: An unseen, all-knowing voice in the sky that keeps the story moving.
